The University of Adelaide is located in the cultural heart of Adelaide, the capital city of South Australia. All four of the University's campuses are located on the lands of the Kaurna People, the traditional owners for thousands of years prior to the beginning of European settlement in 1836.

The city has welcomed migrants from all over the world and is characterized by a great diversity of cultural traditions, languages spoken (although English is the official language) and systems of belief.

Its central location makes it an ideal gateway to explore South Australia's many attractions, from world-renowned wineries, beautiful hills and rugged coastlines to the Australian outback.
